## BYLAW 2023-3 RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GARRY # 245

## BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY.

Section 12, The Heritage Property Act, R.S.S. 1978, c.H-2.2, as amended

A bylaw of the RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GARRY # 245 to designate a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of THE HERITAGE PROPERTY ACT authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has determined that the lands and premises known as:

UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC PARISH OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY AT BEAVERDALE, SASKATCHEWAN

and located at:

## SE 13-26-08-W2

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, palaeontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and,

**WHEREAS** 

the Council of the Municipality has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a). served on the owners of said property;
- b). served on the Registrar of Heritage Property;
- c). registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate Land Titles Office.
- d). published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1]. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

All that portion of the South East quarter of Section Thirteen (13) in Township Twenty-Six (26) in Range Eight (8) West of the Second Meridian, in the province of Saskatchewan in the country of Canada. More particularly described as follows: Commencing at the South West corner of the said quarter section, thence Northerly along the Western boundary of the said

quarter section a distance of Fifty (50) meters, thence Easterly parallel to the Southern boundary of the said Quarter section a distance of Eighty point Five (80.5) meters, thence Southerly parallel to the said Western boundary a Distance of Fifty (50) meters more or less to a point in said Southern boundary, thence Westerly along the said Southern boundary a distance of Eighty point Five (80.5) meters more or less, to the place of commencement.

Subject to the mineral exceptions reservations and conditions contained in an instrument registered as No. B.C. 12gi

and located at: four miles south of Jedburgh

The reasons for the proposed designation are as follows;

- 1. The unique architectural style of the church.
- 2. The grandeur of the interior of the church
- 3. The emotional and spiritual significance for the parishioners of the area.
- 2]. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of designation to be:
  - a. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office.
  - Served on the owners of said property.

3]. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.
