**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GARRY # 245**

**BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY.**

Section 12, The Heritage Property Act, R.S.S. 1978, c.H-2.2, as amended

A bylaw of the **RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GARRY # 245** to designate a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

**WHEREAS** Sections 11 and 12 of *THE HERITAGE PROPERTY ACT* authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipality has determined that the lands and premises known as:

UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC PARISH OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY AT  
BEAVERDALE, SASKATCHEWAN

and located at:

**SE 13-26-08-W2**

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, palaeontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and,

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipality has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a). served on the owners of said property;
- b). served on the Registrar of Heritage Property;
- c). registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate Land Titles Office.
- d). published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

**WHEREAS** no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;

**THEREFORE**, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1]. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

All that portion of the South East quarter of Section Thirteen (13) in Township Twenty-Six (26) in Range Eight (8) West of the Second Meridian, in the province of Saskatchewan in the country of Canada. More particularly described as follows: Commencing at the South West corner of the said quarter section, thence Northerly along the Western boundary of the said quarter section a distance of Fifty (50) meters, thence Easterly parallel to the Southern boundary of the said Quarter section a distance of Eighty point Five (80.5) meters, thence Southerly parallel to the said Western boundary a Distance of Fifty (50) meters more or less to a point in said Southern boundary, thence Westerly along the said Southern boundary a distance of Eighty point Five (80.5) meters more or less, to the place of commencement.

**Subject to the mineral exceptions reservations and conditions contained in an instrument registered as No. B.C. 12gi**

and located at: four miles south of Jedburgh

*The reasons for the proposed designation are as follows;*

1. *The unique architectural style of the church.*
2. *The grandeur of the interior of the church*
3. *The emotional and spiritual significance for the parishioners of the area.*

2]. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of designation to be:

- a. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office.
- b. Served on the owners of said property.

3]. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.
