## BYLAW 2017-2

## **RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GARRY # 245**

## A BYLAW TO LICENSE THE DRILLING OF OIL AND GAS WELLS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Garry No. 245 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw:
  - a. "Contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation;
  - b. "Drilling" shall mean drilling of any kind for the purposes of oil or gas; and
  - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Garry No. 245;
- 2. Any contractor undertaking drilling in the municipality shall pay to the municipality the following license fee:

a. for the drilling of an oil well or a gas well,

\$450.00

b. for the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information,

\$225.00

3. Bylaw No. 91-3 is hereby repealed.
