BYLAW 01-2023

A BYLAW FOR THE REVIEW OF THE DIVISION BOUNDARIES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY


Section 49 *The Municipalities Act*

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rudy No. 284 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the *Division Boundary Review Bylaw*.
2. In this Bylaw:
 - a) “Act” means the *Municipalities Act*.
 - b) “Council” means the Council of the RM.
 - c) “Division Boundary” means the borders within the RM that separate the electoral divisions as approved by the Minister.
 - d) “RM” means the Rural Municipality of Rudy No. 284.
 - e) “Minister” means the minister as defined by the Act.
3. The purpose of this Bylaw is to provide the manner for the RM to maintain equality in the number of voters among divisions, as is reasonably practicable.
4. When a review is required, council will appoint a Committee to conduct the review and report back to council at a regularly scheduled council meeting in 60 days or less, with remuneration subject to the Council Indemnity Policy.
5. A review of division boundaries is required when RM experiences:
 - a) A significant population change
 - b) A large development project proposal
 - c) Establishment of a Community of Interest
6. Additional factors affecting the review include:
 - a) Natural geographic boundaries and physical features
 - b) Reasonable practicality of making a boundary change
7. The Committee’s report to council will be available for public inspection at the RM office during regular office hours for a minimum of ten business days before council considers a resolution to change a division boundary in the RM.
