BYLAW NO. 1/88

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 to designate the property known as the Bethel Church located on a portion of the SE 2-38-13 W2 in the Province of Saskatchewan as being a site of architectural and historical value.

WHEREAS part 111 of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures theron, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Bethel Church on a portion of the SE 2-38-13 W2 a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the administrator of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 enacts as follows:

There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as the Bethel Norwegian Luthern Church in the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 and legally described as:

All that portion of the South East quarter of Section Two (2) in Township Thirty Eight (38) in Range Thirteen (13) West of the second meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan in the Dominion of Canada more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point in the Southern Boundary in the said quarter section a distance of nine hundred and seventy three and five tenths (973&5/10) feet more or less measured Westerly from the South East Corner of the said quarter section; thence northerly and parallel to the Eastern Boundary of said quarter section a distance of Two hundred and Eighteen and five tenths (218&5/10) feet more or less: thence Westerly and parallel to the said Southern Boundary of the said quarter section a distance of Two hundred and Eighteen and five tenths (218&5/10) feet more or less to a point in the said Southern Boundary; thence Easterly along the said Southern Boundary a distance of Four Hundred and one (401) feet more or less to the place warter section a distance of of commencement.

Subject to the exceptions, reservations and provisoes respecting mines, minerals and mineral oils as the same are more fully set forth in the grant from the Crown registered in the Land Titles Office for the Humboldt Land Registration District as No. 54-56. "Minerals in the Crown.

The significance of the site is as follows:

- Constructed in 1927, the Bethel Church is one of the earliest churches built in the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367.
- The building is a landmark in the rural community.
- The rural administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
- The rural administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
- This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing therof.
