

**Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw**

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PONASS LAKE NO. 367**

**BYLAW NO 2/25**

**A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
  - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
4. Bylaw No. 2/18 is hereby repealed.

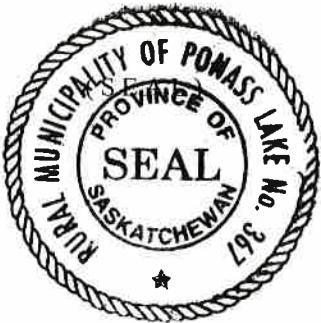

**SCHEDULE “A”**

PUMPER/TANKER TRUCK (Rates are per truck)

\$700.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> hour

\$300.00 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> & subsequent hours or portion thereof

SIDE x SIDE

\$100.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> hour

\$50.00 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> & subsequent hours or portion thereof

FOAM

\$300.00 per pail

FIREFIGHTER FEES

Fire Chief and all members-\$35.00 per hour for call attended with a minimum of 3 hours applying
