## APPENDIX "K" The Pest Control Act Chapter 243, R.S.S., 1965

## BYLAW No. 20 - 1979

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 of the province of Saska tchewan.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:

"department" means the Department of Agriculture for the Province of Saskatchewan;

"municipality" means the Bural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367;

"owner" includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land or premises
in the municipality.

The Pest Control Products (Saskatchewan) Act, 1973, Chapter 72 and regulations

thereof shall apply.

The Council of the municipality shall obtain and keep on hand a supply of redenticide recommended by the department as suitable for the destruction of rats, in quantities deemed sufficient for eradication; and the Council of the municipality shall supply the redenticide to owners of land within the municipality on his request and on such terms and conditions as Council deems

advisable.

Council is hereby authorized to employ pest control officers of the municipality to eradicate rats within the municipality and to take any other methods of

eradicating rats within the municipality.

The municipality is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with other municipalities for joint action to eradicate rats including the appointment of a joint committee or committees to control, supervise and manage a program or programs for the eradication of rats pursuant to the agreement including the purchase of equipment and the hireing of operators thereof. The municipality is hereby authorized to appoint representatives to the joint committee established under the provisions of section (5) of the bylaw to represent the municipality. The municipality is also authorized to make the expenditures of funds to implement this agreement and to meet the expenses

incurred in the agreement. Every owner of land within the municipality shall take the following measures

to eradicate the rats upon his land.

(a) he shall provide suitable rodenticide stations where-ever required on land or other premises owned, occupied, or controlled by him according to the recommendation of the department or a pest control officer of the municipality.

(b) he shall keep the said stations continuously stocked with an adequate supply of redenticide to the recommendations of the department or a

pest control officer of the municipality.

(c) he shall take all necessary precautions to protect humans, livestock and other animals from the rodenticide.

(d) he shall post the premises where rodenticide stations have been estab-

lished with signs supplied by the municipality.

(e) he shall remove or destroy or alter any harborage or potential harborage for rats and shall do do in a manner recommended by the department or a pest control officer of the municipality.

(f) he shall report to the pest control officer of the municipality the existence or suspected existence of rats on land or other premises owned, occupied or controlled by him in the municipality and shall take such measures to eradicate rats as may be recommended by the department or a pest control officer of the municipality.

8.	Pursuant to Sections 19, 20 and 21 of the Pest Control Act where the owner does not take the measures required by him pursuant to section (7) of this bylaw a pest control officer of the municipality may issue an order to that owner
	requiring him to eradicate rats upon any land or other premises owned, occupied or controlledby him. If the owner neglects or fails to comply with such an order the officer may take the steps necessary to carry out the work required by the
	order and the costs thereof, if not sconer paid, shall be added to the taxes, on the 31st of December in the year in which expenses were incurred on the parcel of
9.	land or the premises on which the work was done. This bylaw shall continue in force until such time as repealed by Council.
