## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PONASS LAKE NO. 367 BYLAW NO. 3, 1990

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 to designate the property known as the Scrip United Church located on a portion of the NW 34-37-15 N2 in the Province of Saskatchewan as being a site of architectural and historical value.

WHEREAS part 111 of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Scrip United Church on a portion of the NW 34-37-15 W2 a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the administrator of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 enacts as follows:

There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as the Scrip United Church in the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 and legally described as:

All that portion of the North West quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), in Township Thirty-seven (37), in Range Fifteen (15), West of the Second Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, more particularly described as follows: commencing: at the commencing: at the north east corner of the said quarter section, thence westerly along the northern boundary thereof a distance of one hundred and ten (110) feet, thence southerly parallel to the eastern boundary of the said quarter section, a distance of one hundred and sixty-five (165) feet, thence easterly parallel to the northern boundary of the said quarter section to the east boundary of the said quarter section, thence northerly along the said eastern boundary to the point of commencement and containing four tenths (0.4) of an acre, more or less.

## MINERALS IN THE CROWN..

The significance of the site is as follows:

- Constructed in 1933, the Scrip United Church is one of the earliest Churches built in the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367
- The architectural designs of the Church reflect Scandinavian b. motifs.
- The Church is the last standing building of the Scrip community.
- The building is a landmark in the community. d.
- The rural administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
- The rural administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this 3. bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
