
BYLAW NO. 5, 1997

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES

Whereas the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires; therefore,

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Ponass Lake No. 367 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned and operated landfill located Pt. NW 3-39-13 W2.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
