

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF THE GAP NO. 39

BYLAW NO. 4/2018

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE SPEED OF VEHICLES EXCEEDING GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHTS OF 10 TONNE

The Council of the Rural Municipality of The Gap No. 39 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Overweight Vehicle Speed Restriction Bylaw"
2. In this bylaw the expression:
 - a. "**Public highway**" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the *Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, but **shall not include** a provincial highway as designated pursuant to said act
 - b. "**Vehicle**" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the *Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*
 - c. "**Gross Vehicle Weight**" shall mean the prescribed or ordered weight as determined by the vehicle registration as issued by Saskatchewan Government Insurance
 - d. "**Municipality**" means the Rural Municipality of The Gap No. 39, Council, its employees or employees whose employment requires them to undertake certain works under this bylaw
3. A person operating a vehicle with a Gross Vehicle Weight exceeding 10 Tonne shall not travel at a speed greater than 70 kilometers per hour on any public highway within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of The Gap No. 39
4. Signs indicating both the Speed Limit and the Gross Vehicle Weight restriction shall be erected:

At the North Municipal Boundary for the following Range Roads:
Rge Road 211
Rge Road 194


At the East Municipal Boundary for the following Township Roads:
Twp Road 42 Twp Road 50
Twp Road 52 Twp Road 60

At the South Municipal Boundary for the following Range Roads:
Rge Road 214

At the West Municipal Boundary for the following Township Roads:
Twp Road 52 Twp Road 60
Twp Road 62

As well as off of Highway 377 on the following Range Roads:
Rge Road 192
Rge Road 194

As well as off of Clearing The Path (CTP) Grid Road 705 on the following Range Roads:
Rge Road 191
Rge Road 200
