

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF RENO NO. 51
BYLAW NO. 161/94**


A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTING THE OPERATION OF TRACTORS AND CERTAIN VEHICLES ON ROADS IN THE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 206(2)(F) OF *THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989*.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Reno No. 51 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council may by resolution appoint a committee comprised of two of its members, with authority on behalf of the municipality, subject to Section 3 hereof, to issue orders in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs:
 - (i) restricting the gross weight of vehicles, where the gross weight of the vehicle is in excess of 350 pounds per inch (6.25 kg/mm) width of tire (manufacturers stamped dimension) on any wheel except those on the steering axle of any power unit or truck, which shall be restricted to 390 pounds per inch (7.0 kg/mm) width of tire, travelling on specified roads or bridges in the municipality;
 - (ii) with respect to vehicles referred to in subclause (i), restricting the gross weight that may be transmitted to the road through any point or points of contact of the vehicles travelling on specified roads or bridges in the municipality;

AT ANY TIME AND FOR ANY PERIOD MENTIONED IN SUCH ORDER

2. The committee may rescind or vary any order under Section 1 within the limits of its authority herein.
3. Section 72 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84* makes it an offence to violate the provisions of an Order issued pursuant to this bylaw.
4. No person shall operate a power unit, truck or other vehicle in contravention of an order made by a committee pursuant to this bylaw.
5. This bylaw and any order made pursuant thereto shall be subject in all respects to the regulations prescribed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs as set forth in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
6. No person shall deface, injure, knock down, or remove any notice posted by authority of a committee appointed under this bylaw.

Order No. 1 - 2013
(Bylaw No. 161/94)

1. Pursuant to Bylaw No. 161/94, no person shall operate a power unit, truck, tractor or any other vehicle, the weight of which its load exceeds:

2. Any person or persons found guilty of a violation of this order or of any of the provisions of Bylaw No. 161/94, shall be subject to the penalties provided for in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.

3. This order shall come into effect on the 21st day of March, 2013 at Midnight and shall remain in effect until rescinded by a committee of council.
