BYLAW NO. 226/15

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES AND SNOW FENCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Reno No. 51, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council, or its designated agent, is hereby authorized to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting snow fences as a measure to prevent the blocking of roads by snow drifts during winter months.
2. The agent authorized by Council to perform the work as herein provided shall have the right of entry on private property for such purpose only.
3. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the Municipality engaged in carrying out the provisions of this Bylaw, or who destroys, pulls down, alters or interferes with any works carried out or things done under the authority of this Bylaw, shall be liable on summary of conviction to the penalties prescribed by the Penalties for Contravention of Bylaw No. 206/07 of the Rural Municipality of Reno No. 51.
4. Bylaw No. 127/71 is hereby repealed.
