## RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF RENO NO. 51 BYLAW 259/25

## A BYLAW TO LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION AND EXTINGUISHING SERVICE DIRECTLY ON PERSONS WHO RECEIVE THE **SERVICE**

The council of the Rural Municipality of Reno No. 51, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. That the cost of fire prevention and extinguishing services be billed directly to the person or persons who receive the service.
- 2. That the "person who received the service" be defined as the registered owner of The land, building, vehicle, or other equipment that the fire, or other situation occurred on.
- 3. That the **rates** for the above-mentioned services be set as follows:

RATEPAYERS - Basic Call - minimum charge of \$600.00/per hour; Maximum of \$2500.00 Plus any cost for foam, if used.

NON-RATEPAYERS – Based on Saskatchewan Government Insurance Rates 2025 rate is \$1,107.67 (Total Time x Rate = Total Claim for Service)

- 4. Notification by phone call to the ratepayer being charged shall be made prior to the invoice being sent out.
- 5. In the event of a dispute arising through billing, decisions shall be made by Council at their discretion and that decision shall be binding.

6. Bylaw No. 258/25 is hereby repealed.
