

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF RENO NO. 51
BYLAW 259/25

**A BYLAW TO LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION AND
EXTINGUISHING SERVICE DIRECTLY ON PERSONS WHO RECEIVE THE
SERVICE**

The council of the Rural Municipality of Reno No. 51, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That the cost of fire prevention and extinguishing services be billed directly to the person or persons who receive the service.
2. That the "person who received the service" be defined as the registered owner of The land, building, vehicle, or other equipment that the fire, or other situation occurred on.
3. That the **rates** for the above-mentioned services be set as follows:

RATEPAYERS – Basic Call – minimum charge of \$600.00/per hour; Maximum of \$2500.00 Plus any cost for foam, if used.

NON-RATEPAYERS – Based on Saskatchewan Government Insurance Rates
- 2025 rate is \$1,107.67 (Total Time x Rate = Total Claim for Service)

4. Notification by phone call to the ratepayer being charged shall be made prior to the invoice being sent out.
5. In the event of a dispute arising through billing, decisions shall be made by Council at their discretion and that decision shall be binding.
6. Bylaw No. 258/25 is hereby repealed.
