

## **SNOW PLOWING POLICY**

1) Priority order for plowing roads in a **significant** snow event, as declared by each councilor for their division shall be as follows:

- Primary Grid (Green on RM Map) and Secondary grid roads (Red on RM Map)
- Municipal Grid (Brown on RM Map)
- Main Farm Access Roads (Blue on RM Map)

*This order is subject to change upon council discretion due to road conditions in each division.*

All regular snow plowing/road maintenance will be done at the foreman and road committee's discretion.

**\*\*Yard site/Residences are the responsibility of the ratepayer\*\***

- 2) The councilor for each Division, or their appointed agent will, be responsible for ordering the plow from the road committee and foreman.
- 3) Any additional roads requested to be plowed will be at the individual ratepayer's expense, where current custom rates apply, with a minimum charge of one hour.
- 4) A ratepayer may hire an outside source to plow access roads if needed, this is to be done at the ratepayer's expense.

If anyone other than RM employees with RM snowplows wishes to, or is hired to plow on a municipal roads a **Snow Plow Application is required** to be filed with the RM of Reno No. 51. See Snow Plowing-Application for RM requirements *prior* to operating on Municipal Roads.
