

## **TEXAS GATE POLICY**

### **RESOLUTION NO. 167/08**

All Texas gates installed on any RM right of way are subject to the approval of Council.

The applicant must also complete a Texas gate registration form for office records.

All adjacent land owners must be notified by the RM that an application has been made, and any tangible issues arising must be brought to Council and addressed prior to Council's approval of application. Furthermore, if there is no tangible proof that the Texas gate will adversely affect the adjacent owner's farming or ranching, then Council can still approve of the Texas gate.

All Texas gates shall be 21 feet long and 8 feet wide and shall have a pass gate, in accordance with Saskatchewan Highways & Transportation Requirements.

Proper signage shall be posted at each Texas gate location; one "CATTLE AT LARGE" and one "TEXAS GATE AHEAD"; all required signage shall be at the expense of the landowner.

All Texas gates shall be kept in such a state of repair that motorists exercising ordinary care may pass over the same safely and that it will serve to confine livestock.

The applicant shall assume all liability for installation costs and maintenance to standards as listed above.

This policy is not applicable to farmyard driveways.
