RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WAWKEN NO. 93 BYLAW NO. 5/2017

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WAWKEN NO. 93 TO PROVIDE FOR FIRE PROTECTIVE SERVICES COST RECOVERY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- In this Bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the municipality;

b) "Council" shall mean the Council of the municipality;

c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93; and

d) "Fire Response" shall mean any response by:

- i) WWW Fire Protection District, and
- ii) The Kennedy Fire Department.
- The cost of fire prevention. Suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with:
 - a) The current rates as charged from the responding fire service as determined by the respective Boards of the WWW Fire Protection District and the Kennedy Fire Department.
- The Council hereby authorizes the Administrator to invoice the ratepayer(s) for the cost of the fire protection services promptly following the date the service was received and the invoiced fees shall be payable directly to the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93.
- The Council hereby authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property (land, improvement or business) owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this Bylaw any amount which remains unpaid after 90 days.
- All funds relating to fire protective services, collected by the Administrator, shall be forwarded on to the respective Boards of the WWW Fire Protection District and the Kennedy Fire Department.
- No person shall refuse fire service.
- 7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately.
