


BYLAW NO. 6/97


A BYLAW RESPECTING THE EXCAVATING, FILLING, CLEARING BUSH, INJURING, ENCUMBERING AND OBSTRUCTING OF ROADS, DITCHES AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "municipal road" means any public highway that is under the direction, management and control of the rural municipality.
 - b) "rural municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93.
2. No person shall excavate, fill, clear bush or otherwise injure a municipal road, ditch or other public place in the rural municipality without Council approval.
3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the rural municipality.
