THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WAWKEN NO. 93 ENACTS A BYLAW TO LICENCE MINING AND WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 213 (1) (b) OR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- For the purpose of this bylaw, the word "contractor" shall include andy person, firm or corporation.
- Every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a Business Tax in the Municipality, shall before undertaking well-drilling in the Municipality, pay to the Municipality the following Licence Fee:
 - a) For the drilling of an oil well or a gas well*

 * Add: "9" Legs" ---.

\$450.00

b) For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled fro seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information.

\$225.00

- Any contractor holding a licence under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his licence when required to do so by the Licence Inspector, Police Officer or other authorized person.
